Following programs are amalgamation of cultural practices and modern medical care.

- 1) **Walawalkar Sukanya Yojana**-Health Checkup and Counseling of adolescent girls of rural areas with particular attention to menstrual, psychological, emotional, and nutritional and hygiene practices.
- 2) **Walawalkar Yashoda yojana**- antenatal camps are conducted by house household survey and aganwadi visits to identify “high risk approach” and awareness about institutional delivery is created
- 3) **Walawalkar pooja ceremony**-The Mangalagaur Workshops (for newlyweds) prepare young mothers for pregnancy, childbirth and motherhood.
- 4) **The Mother-in-law workshops** help to sensitize them towards the health, nutritional and psychological needs of the daughter-in-law.
- 5) **Walawalkar Ladoo Gopal yojana**-Provision of Nutritious Laddoos to undernourished children in Anganwadis
- 6) **Walawalkar Sudama Yojana**-mother and child are enrolled to create awareness about nutrition and hygiene.
- 7) **Walawalkar common birthday**- monthly birthday celebration to promote immunization and to assess growth and nutrition. Girl child” naming ceremony” to promote immunization & acceptance of girl child
- 8) **Walawalkar Baby Shower Ceremony** help women emphasize their role during pregnancy and avail modern antenatal care.
- 9) **Walawalkar Dant chikitsa Yojana**-Oral and dental screening at schools and colleges in the district.
- 10) **NRHM Mobile medical unit**- to offer medical help to remote and underserved villages.
- 11) **Self-help groups** are created for empowerment of ladies in the villages.
- 12) **Tata memorial rural outreach programs**-Cancer screening, dervan cancer registry- for arranging cancer screening camps in villages.
- 13) **Workshops for anganwadi sevika**, asha, teachers, nurses, medical officers, village leaders for creating awareness about health and nutrition.
