CODE OF CONDUCT



- The students, parents and guardians are specially requested to note that following are the rules and code of conduct for all the students of B.K.L.Walawalkar Rural Medical College
- The Dress Code viz. Student uniform and formal shoes are compulsory in collage and hospital during college hours (wearing chappal is not allowed).
- The data in respect to attendance, scholastic performance and overall progress of the students is recorded and stored in a retrievable from using software program called Students Information System (SIS).Parents are updated regarding the progress of their wards every month by email and postal communication.
- There will be no gathering, no elections and no Student Union to be formed.
- It is imperative that students should attend the collage from the day of opening to the last day of each term during the academic year.
- The students should be regular in attending theory, practical, tutorial, dissection, clinical posting, group discussion and seminar classes.
- The students , parents and guardians should note that if any student fails to complete the required attendance and journals/ term work regularly, he/she will not be granted the term and will not be allowed to appear for university examination.
- The strict disciplinary action will be taken against those students who fail to attend the classes regularly.
- As per Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik 75 % attendance for theory and 80 % attendance for non-theory classes is mandatory. In case of short attendance, term will not be granted.
- In case of absence, the student should inform the college authority in advance and in writing about the reason for absenteeism. However this does not entitle him/her for any relaxation in the required attendance prescribed by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik.
- The students should attend all internal assessment examinations. As per university norms there will be no re exam for absent students.
- The students should regularly complete as per the schedule, their journals/record books and/or any other term work assigned to them.
- Use of mobile phones is not allowed during lectures, practical, clinical posting, etc. if any students is found using mobile during college hours, the mobile will be confiscated.
- The student should note that he/she is responsible to college authority, not only for his/her conduct in the college premise, but also for his/her attitude and behavior outside the college premises. Any observed or reported objectionable conduct within or outside the college premises will make him/her liable for strict disciplinary action.
- The students should help to keep college premises clean and tidy.
- The students should behave politely and decently, so as to enhance his/her own image and also reputation of the institution.
- The students should not participate in any political and antisocial activities.
