Summary

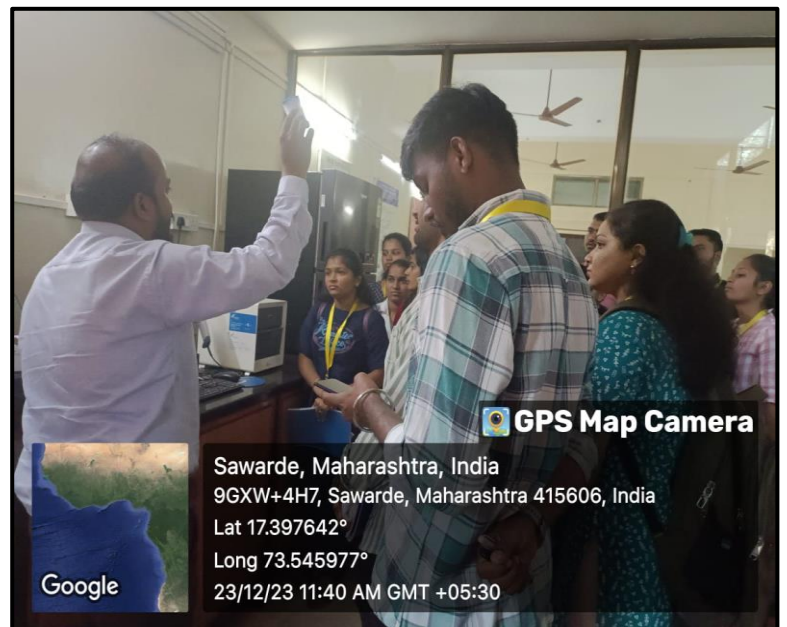
A Sun Pharma sponsored hands-on workshop on “Basic Techniques in Molecular Biology and Animal Tissue Culture” in collaboration with SKLS Pvt. Ltd. was organized at the BKL Walawalkar Rural Medical College from December 21 – December 27, 2023. The workshop was inaugurated by Dr. Amit Nasa, secretary of the Sun Pharma Science Foundation. The aim of the workshop was to expose college students and young scientists from rural India to various techniques used commonly in the research laboratories and biotechnology industry. Practical sessions on pipettes and their handling, isolation, purification, and amplification of DNA/RNA, and gel electrophoresis of DNA/RNA and proteins were included. In addition to practical training, several lectures on relevant topics were delivered by eminent researchers such as Dr. Rita Mulherkar, Dr. Neelam Shirsat, Dr. Saroj Ghaskadbi, Dr. Surendra Ghaskadbi and Dr. Mrinalini Moghe. Students had a wonderful opportunity to meet and interact with these renowned speakers who were present for the entire duration of this workshop. Twenty-two students from Maharashtra, Gujarat and Telangana participated in this workshop.

It has been observed that rural college graduates in biology/cell biology/biotechnology often find themselves lacking essential skills and practical experience necessary for their chosen profession. The objective of this workshop was to bridge this knowledge gap and enhance the skill set of budding researchers. In the long run, best practices of research learned during this training will enhance the quality of research carried out by the students.

She said she had a voracious appetite but had been losing weight recently, she had been having polyuria and Polydipsia for a few months. Physical examination revealed mild dehydration.

Pulse 75 beats/min.

BP 160/90 mmHg.

There was diminished pulsation of posterior tibial and dorsalis pedis arteries of left side.

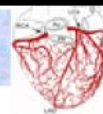

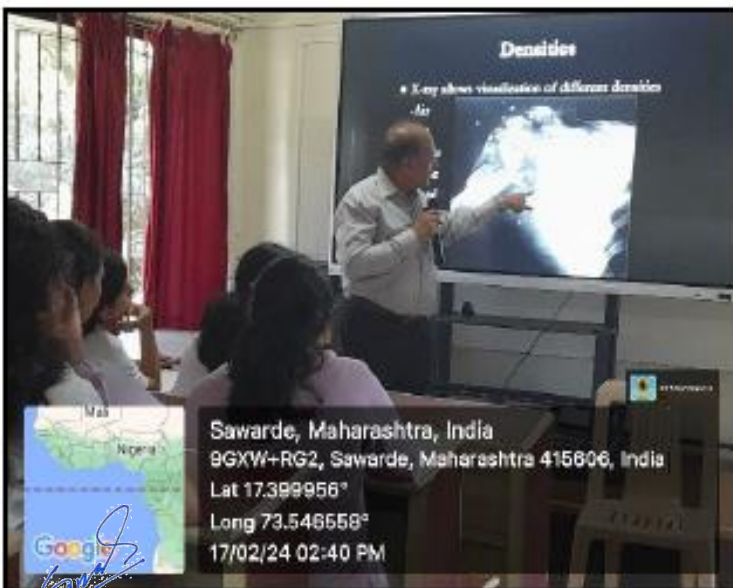

Enhancing Medical Education in Community Medicine
Fishbowl Discussion as an Innovative Teaching Method

Date: 06/01/2024

Introduction:

In the realm of medical education, innovation in teaching methodologies is crucial to foster critical thinking, communication skills, and collaborative learning among students. One such innovative method gaining traction is the fishbowl discussion. This report elucidates the process and outcomes of implementing fishbowl discussions for medical students, highlighting its effectiveness in facilitating active engagement and deeper understanding of medical concepts.

Methodology:

The fishbowl discussion was conducted with a cohort of medical students Batch 2023. The session focused on Attributes of Indian Medical Graduate and skills required to attain the same. This also comes under the topic of AETCOM "What does it mean to be a doctor?"

The participants were divided into two groups: the inner circle (actively participating) and the outer circle (observing and providing feedback). The inner circle consisted of a few students who initiated the discussion, while the outer circle comprised the remaining participants. The discussion was moderated by Dr. Namita Deshmukh and Dr. Avinash Borakar.

After the discussion, inner circle students presented their discussion findings to the entire class. They themselves through discussions found out what are the important skills they need to learn if they want to become a successful IMG. They said it was an eye-opener for them. Later on, the outer circle students talked in brief about the inner circle fish they observed. In this way all the inner circle students got a real time feedback about their communication skills, active listening, working in team, taking initiative, ability of conflict resolution, etc. the outer circle students got an opportunity to learn important elements of communication and group discussions and how to observe these in people.

Fishbowl Discussion for teaching- Dept of Community Medicine

Key Components of Fishbowl Discussion:

1. **Structured Format:** The discussion followed a structured format with designated time slots for each attribute and skills required to achieve them and conclusion.
2. **Active Participation:** Students in the inner circle actively engaged in analyzing the skills required by an IMG to become a competent clinician, communicator, researcher, professional, critical thinker and a health care team leader and opportunities to acquire them. The outer circle observed one participant each from the inner circle on the basis of a structured checklist provided which focused on participant's communication skills, active listening, working in team, taking initiative, ability of conflict resolution, etc.
3. **Peer Learning:** The fishbowl format promoted peer learning, as students shared diverse perspectives, drew upon each other's knowledge, and collaborated to discuss.
4. **Faculty Guidance:** The moderators provided guidance, clarified doubts, and steered the discussion towards deeper exploration, encouraged participation from all students and ensured adherence to time limits.

Outcomes and Observations:

1. **Enhanced Critical Thinking:** Fishbowl discussions stimulated self-review and reflection among students, prompting them to think what all they need to learn in their student life apart from the subjects- a hidden curriculum of soft skills, resilience, communication, team building, rapport building and much more.
2. **Improved Communication Skills:** Students demonstrated enhanced communication skills by articulating their thoughts clearly, actively listening to peers, and effectively conveying complex medical information.
3. **Increased Engagement:** The interactive nature of fishbowl discussions captured students' attention and fostered a sense of ownership in their learning process. This led to increased engagement and enthusiasm during the session.
4. **Deeper Understanding:** Students reported a deeper understanding of the relevance and importance of their responsibility as a doctor towards their profession and patients, as they were actively involved in analyzing real-life requirements of the profession, synthesizing information, and applying theoretical knowledge to practical situations.

Conclusion:

The fishbowl discussion emerges as a valuable innovation in medical education, offering a dynamic platform for active learning, peer collaboration, and skill development.



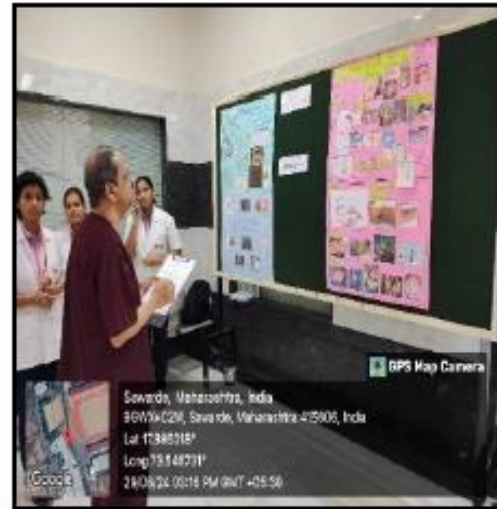
