Report of Community Health Awareness Activity conducted on 10/07/2023 under Family Adoption Program (FAP)



Description of the program & Activities done	<p>Community Awareness Campaign on Diarrhoeal & Vector-borne diseases was conducted by National Service Scheme (NSS) cell & Dept of Community Medicine through house-to-house visits among residents of Dervan village from 9.00 am to 12.00 noon.</p> <p>The residents were sensitized regarding various vector borne diseases, its causes, symptoms, treatment & prevention. One group of 25 students and NSS volunteers done house-to-house visit & created awareness about prevailing vector borne diseases like malaria, dengue, chickengunya & filaria. People were also sensitized for the use of personal protective measures against mosquitoes and other various vectors using posters in Marathi language.</p>

The second group of 25 MBBS students and NSS volunteers created awareness regarding diarrheal diseases during monsoon season. Students provided the information regarding possible causes of water and food contamination. They also explained them the various methods of water disinfection.

The people thanked students for providing useful information on these crucial issues.
