Report on Self-awareness Assessment Boot camp for students



Encourage Personal and Professional Growth: Provide tools to unlock new pathways to success, fulfillment, and resilience. Empower Individuals: Inspire participants to realize their potential by leveraging self-awareness. Facilitate Guided Assessments and Counseling: Offer structured assessments followed by personalized counseling to support participants' journeys.
Description of the program & Activities done	<p>The NSS Cell (2023 Batch), under the leadership of Dr. Namita Deshmukh, Program Officer, organized the Self-Awareness Assessment Boot Camp from January 10 to January 15, 2025, at the NSS room. The program aimed to help participants unlock their full potential by enhancing clarity, confidence, emotional intelligence, and decision-making skills.</p> <p>Using standardized and validated scales, participants' behavioral patterns and emotional intelligence were assessed, and based on the scores, they underwent counseling. Attendees received a detailed report highlighting brain dominance, personality traits,</p>

learning styles, and intelligence quotients. Counseling sessions, starting January 15, 2025, guided participants toward personal and professional growth.


The program received an enthusiastic response, enrolling 60 students. Participants reported feeling more confident post-counseling and expressed that the program helped them understand their strengths and weaknesses while learning strategies to overcome challenges. Many suggested that such a program should be made widely available. Certificates of participation were awarded to all participants.


