Family Adoption Program Report-(01.08.24 to 31.7.25)

As per the direction of the National Medical Commission, BKL Walawalkar Rural Medical College has started the Family Adoption Program (FAP) from 2021 MBBS batch under the guidance of Dr. Gajanan Velhal, professor & Head, Department of Community Medicine. The prime aim of this program is to provide medical students with on-ground hands-on experience from the beginning and also increase the availability and accessibility of doctors or medical professionals in rural areas.

Under this program, MBBS students are allotted two/ three families in rural area. During this period, the students study the various aspects of health and disease influencing factors in the family. They follow the family on a yearly basis from 1st professional year to fourth professional year. This develops a trustworthy and long - lasting relationship with the families which facilitates health seeking behaviour and promote health and prevent disease.

Selection of village & preliminary survey

A formal meeting was held in the department under Dr Velhal Sir, Professor & HOD for planning of FAP with nodal officer, Mentors & field staff for selection of villages & necessary permissions & liaison with local administration. With prior meetings of stake holders & community workers, admission batch wise areas are selected as follows...

1. Admission batch 2021 -- **Dervan village-** Ganeshwadi, Sutarwadi, Baudhwadi, Faujdarwadi, Shirkewadi, Chavanwadi, Baudhwadi
2. Admission batch 2022 - **Sawarde village-** Kasarwadi, Gudekarwadi, Kumbharwadi, Bhuwadwadi, Khotwadi
3. Admission batch 2023-- **Wahal-** Baudhawadi, Bharadwadi, Ghadashiwadi, Morewadi, Bhuwadwadi, Kumbharwadi, Gawakarwadi, Sonarwadi, Telewadi, Bharamnwadi
4. Admission batch 2024 - Kokare, Niwali, Murtawade

Orientation session-

A brief session on the needs and competencies of Family Adoption Programme (FAP) as recommended by the National Medical Council of India is conducted by Nodal officer for each batch. In the session, students are sensitized to the need of reaching out to the rural community and providing health care services to those who are in need. As per the programme the students were briefed about adoption of three families by each student and what is the importance of being a part of the families adopted by them. An introductory session on the FAP log book was also conducted and students were sensitized on how to practically collect information about the adopted families in the field. The details given in the log book were discussed thoroughly. All the basics required for filling the family details, clinical history, clinical examination etc. were highlighted. The doubts, difficulties and barriers were discussed and cleared.


Feedback by students -

The students were instructed to prepare their FAP power point presentation on the families they visited along with the reflection during the Family Adoption Programme and present their experience. Students explain the purpose of visit and sought permission of family before entering the house. The students enjoy the visit and interaction with village people which increases their insight on rural living. All family members co-operation is anticipated.

1. It is observed that students do not practice history taking and case presentation and also do not complete their journals on time. Therefore, as this is the last clinical posting in Community Medicine, the department wants to ensure that all the students present cases and complete their journals in the stipulated time only. Journals will not be checked once the posting is over.

Students should not remain absent for even a single day. Moreover, students should visit the Medicine, Paediatrics and OBGY wards in the evening and take one case everyday as a part of practice for exams and discuss the cases with their mentors on Friday or as per the mentor's convenience and get the journal signed by the assigned mentor only. Mentors will keep a record of number of cases seen by the students allotted to them and take efforts in improving their case-presentation skills by discussing the cases once a week. Every Friday will be dedicated to this exercise.

2. Skill assessment: Scenarios will be given by the assigned faculty and students will solve
3. Anthropometry: Each student should correctly demonstrate measuring all important anthropometric parameters in the class itself.
4. Statistics and Epidemiological exercises: Problems will be given, students have to solve in class itself.
5. **Family Adoption Program (FAP)-**

8. It is observed that students do not practice history taking and case presentation and also do not complete their journals on time. Therefore, as this is the last clinical posting in Community Medicine, the department wants to ensure that all the students present cases and complete their journals in the stipulated time only. Journals will not be checked once the posting is over.

Students should not remain absent for even a single day. Moreover, students should visit the Medicine, Paediatrics and OBGY wards in the evening and take one case everyday as a part of practice for exams and discuss the cases with their mentors on Friday or as per the mentor's convenience and get the journal signed by the assigned mentor only. Mentors will keep a record of number of cases seen by the students allotted to them and take efforts in improving their case-presentation skills by discussing the cases once a week. Every Friday will be dedicated to this exercise.

11. Statistics and Epidemiological exercises: Problems will be given, students have to solve in class itself.



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

