Family Adoption Program Report- (01.08.2023 to 31.07.2024)

As per the direction of the National Medical Commission, BKL Walawalkar Rural Medical College has started the Family Adoption Program (FAP) from 2021 MBBS batch under the guidance of Dr. Gajanan Velhal, Head of the Department, Department of Community Medicine. The prime aim of this program is to provide medical students with on-ground hands-on experience from the beginning and also increase the availability and accessibility of doctors or medical professionals in rural areas.

Under this program, MBBS students are allotted three families in rural area. During this, the students study the various aspects of health and disease influencing factors in the family. They follow the family on a yearly basis from 1st year to internship period. This develops a trustworthy and long-lasting relationship with the families which will facilitate health seeking behaviour and promote health and prevent disease.

1st PROFESSIONAL YEAR

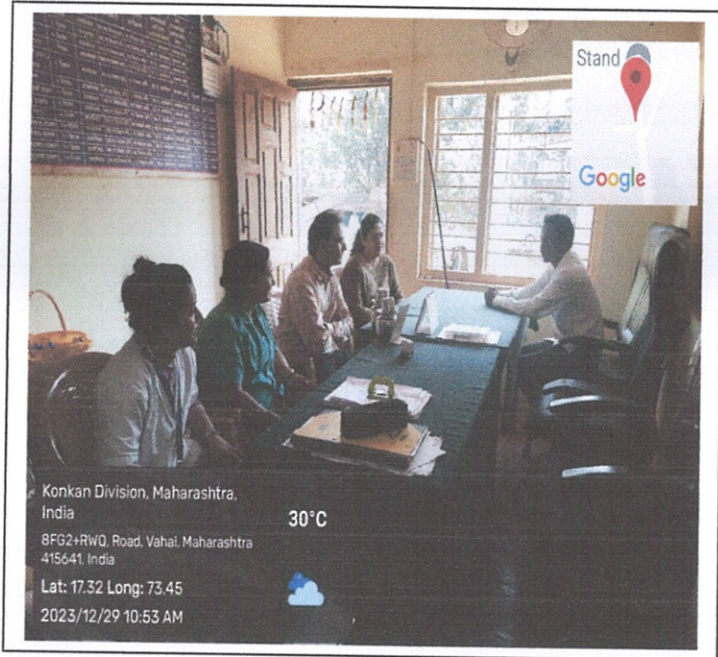
Selection of village & preliminary survey

A formal meeting was held in the department under Dr Velhal Sir, Professor & HOD for planning of FAP for 2023 batch on 28 November 2023. Vahal village was decided for 2023 batch. Dr Avinash Borkar, Associate Professor was appointed as overall in-charge of Family Adoption Program and asked to prepare blueprint of FAP Journal as per the guidelines of NMC. A preliminary survey was done in the area to identify the families by MSW & Interns on 09/12/2023.

A meeting was held with the Sarpanch of Vahal village, Mr Shelar and ASHA workers on 29/12/2023 and prior permission was sought. Schedule was prepared as follow-

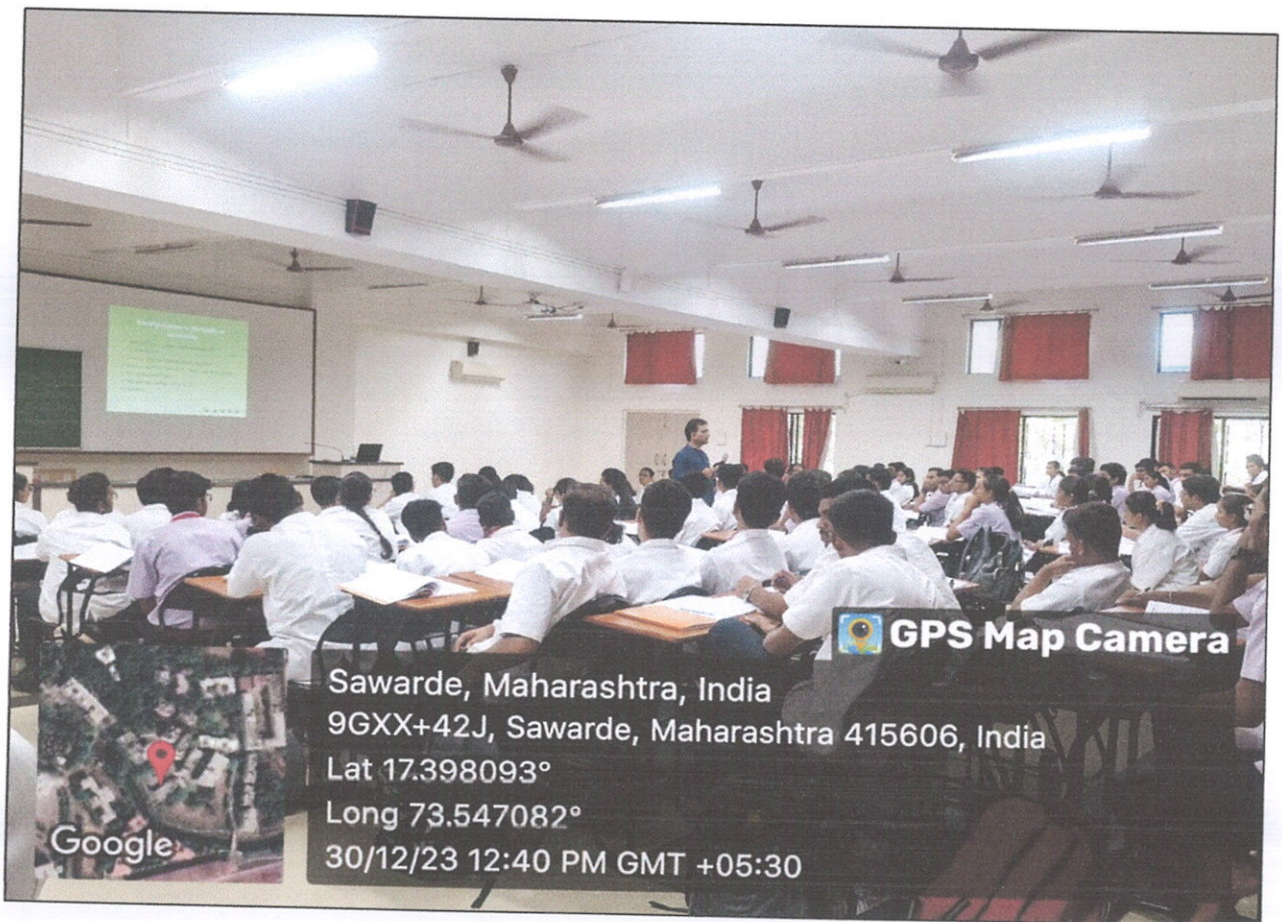

Orientation session-

A brief session on the needs and competencies of Family Adoption Programme (FAP) as recommended by the National Medical Council of India was conducted by Dr Avinash Borkar, Associate Professor from 11.00 am to 1.00 pm on 30th December 2023. In the session, students were sensitized to the need of reaching out to the rural community and providing health care services to those who are in need. As per the programme the students were briefed about adoption of three families by each student and what is the importance of being a part of the families adopted by them. An introductory session on the FAP log book was also conducted and students were sensitized on how to practically collect information about the adopted families in the field. The details given in the log book were discussed thoroughly. All the basics required for filling the family details, clinical history, clinical examination etc. were highlighted. The doubts, difficulties and barriers were discussed and cleared.



Visit to village & families-

After sensitizing the students on Family Adoption Programme, they were taken to the community for their first FAP field visit along with the team of Faculty, Interns and paramedical team members. On the day of visit, students were transported to village in college buses. On reaching the assigned villages, the students were divided into ten teams with five members in each team. The family members co-operated well with the students. The detailed history of each family including socio-demographic profile and clinical examination were recorded as per the FAP document. The students interacted well with the family members and all the families gave a positive response to our visit. Every student allotted 3 families in the area.

Review-

The students were instructed to prepare their FAP power point presentation on the families they visited along with the reflection during the Family Adoption Programme and present their experience and periodic review of visit was planned and taken as per the attached timetable .

Previous batches FAP program

In addition to above, the FAP program for admission batch 2021 is continued in their phase 3 clinical posting schedule as per the batches divided in the area of Ganeshwadi, Sutarwadi , Baudhwadi, Faujdarwadi, Shirkewadi etc. as per allotment done in their 1st phase .

For admission batch 2022, as per the clinical rotation in phase 2 , the visits and reviews were conducted as per the time table attached herewith in their allotted area.

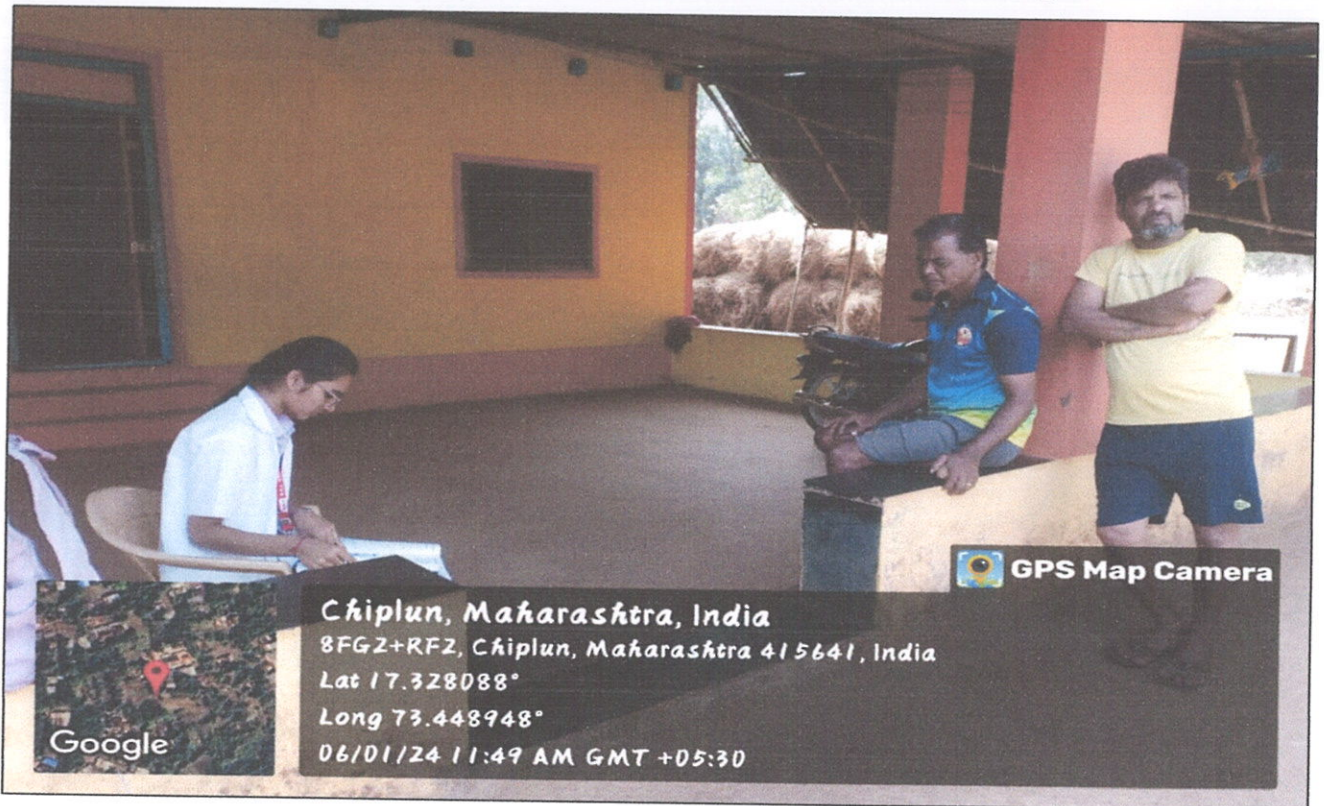

1. It is observed that students do not practice history taking and case presentation and also do not complete their journals on time. Therefore, as this is the last clinical posting in Community Medicine, the department wants to ensure that all the students present cases and complete their journals in the stipulated time only. Journals will not be checked once the posting is over.

Students should not remain absent for even a single day. Moreover, students should visit the Medicine, Paediatrics and OBGY wards in the evening and take one case everyday as a part of practice for exams and discuss the cases with their mentors on Friday or as per the mentor's convenience and get the journal signed by the assigned mentor only. 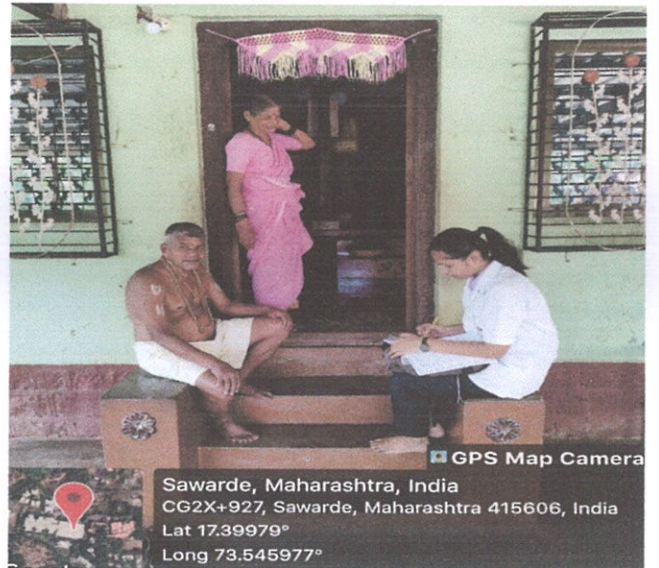
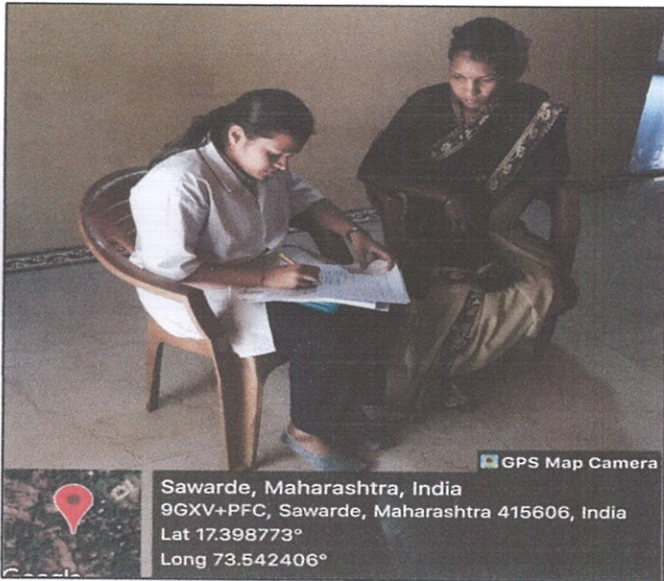
