Family Adoption Program Report-(01.08.2022 to 31.07.2023)

As per the direction of the National Medical Commission, BKL Walawalkar Rural Medical College has started the Family Adoption Program (FAP) from 2021 MBBS batch under the guidance of Dr. Gajanan Velhal, Professor & Head, Department of Community Medicine. The prime aim of this program is to provide medical students with on-ground hands-on experience from the beginning and also increase the availability and accessibility of doctors or medical professionals in rural areas.

Under this program, MBBS students are allotted three families in rural area. During this, the students study the various aspects of health and disease influencing factors in the family. They follow the family on a yearly basis from 1st phase to 3rd phase. This develops a trustworthy and long - lasting relationship with the families which will facilitate health seeking behaviour and promote health and prevent disease.

1st PROFESSIONAL YEAR

Selection of village & preliminary survey

A formal meeting was held in the department under Dr Velhal Sir, Professor & HOD for planning of FAP for 2022 batch on 22 December 2022. Sawarde village was decided for 2022 batch. Dr Avinash Borkar, Associate Professor was appointed as overall in-charge of Family Adoption Program. Family Adoption Program Journals were distributed to all students.

A meeting was held with the Sarpanch of Sawarde village, Mrs Sukeshini Mohite and ASHA workers on 06/01/2023 and prior permission was obtained. A preliminary survey was done in the area to identify the families by MSW & Interns on 14/01/2023 and 17/01/2023.

Orientation session-

A brief session on the needs and competencies of Family Adoption Programme (FAP) as recommended by the National Medical Council of India was conducted by Dr Avinash Borkar, Associate Professor from 11.00 am to 1.00 pm on 21st January 2023. In the session, students were sensitized to the need of reaching out to the rural community and providing health care services to those who are in need. As per the programme the students were briefed about adoption of two families by each student and what is the importance of being a part of the families adopted by them. An introductory session on the FAP log book was also conducted and students were sensitized on how to practically collect information about the adopted families in the field. The details given in the log book were discussed thoroughly. All the basics required for filling the family details, clinical history, clinical examination etc. were highlighted. The doubts, difficulties and barriers were discussed and cleared.

Visit to village & families-

After sensitizing the students on Family Adoption Programme, they were taken to the community for their first FAP field visit on 11th & 25th February 2023 along with the team of Faculty, Interns and paramedical team members. On the day of visit, 75 students were transported to village in two buses. Every batch was allotted separate area & each student given two families. On reaching the assigned villages, the students were divided into ten teams with five members in each team. The family members co-operated well with the students. The detailed history of each family including socio-demographic profile and clinical examination were recorded as per the FAP document. The students interacted well with the family members and all the families gave a positive response to our visit.

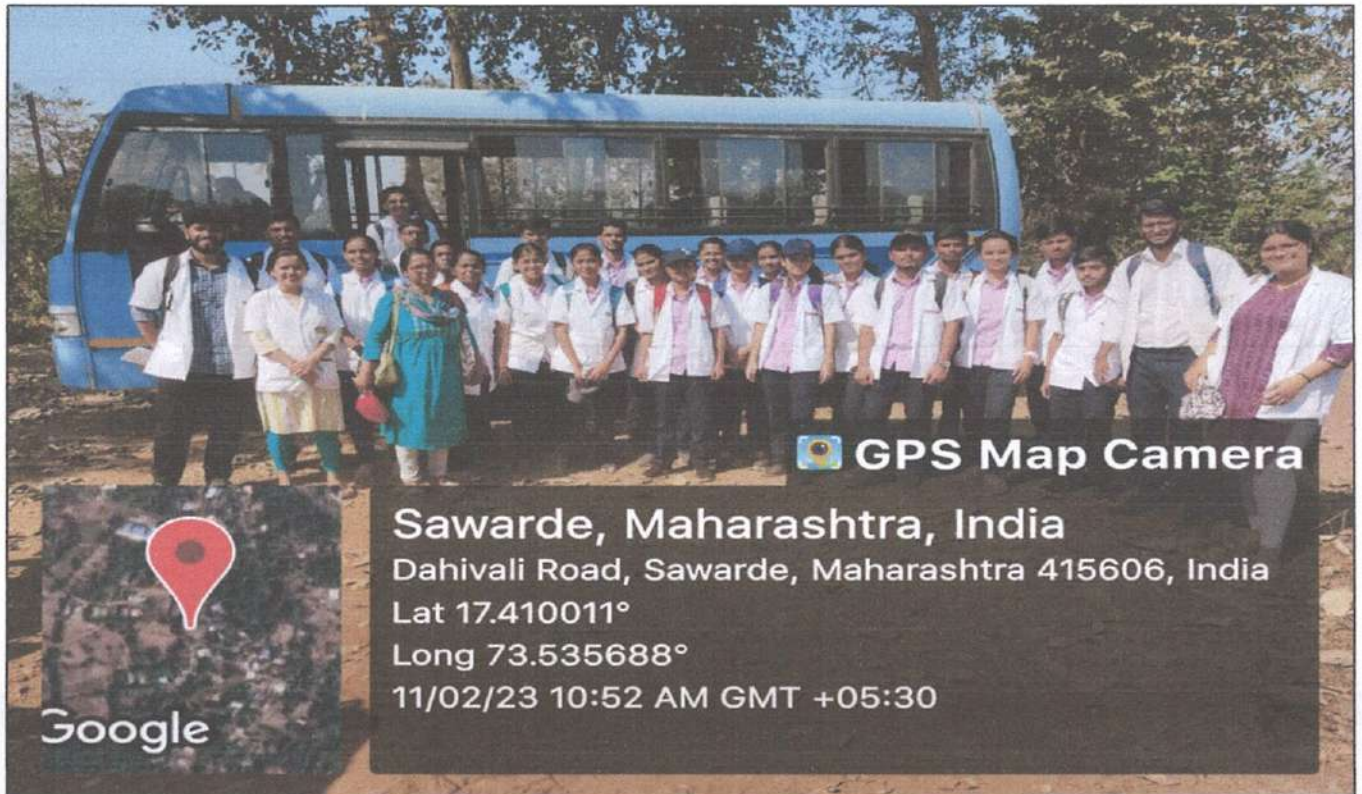
Subsequent visits were done on 01/04/2023, 08/04/2023 and 15/04/2023.

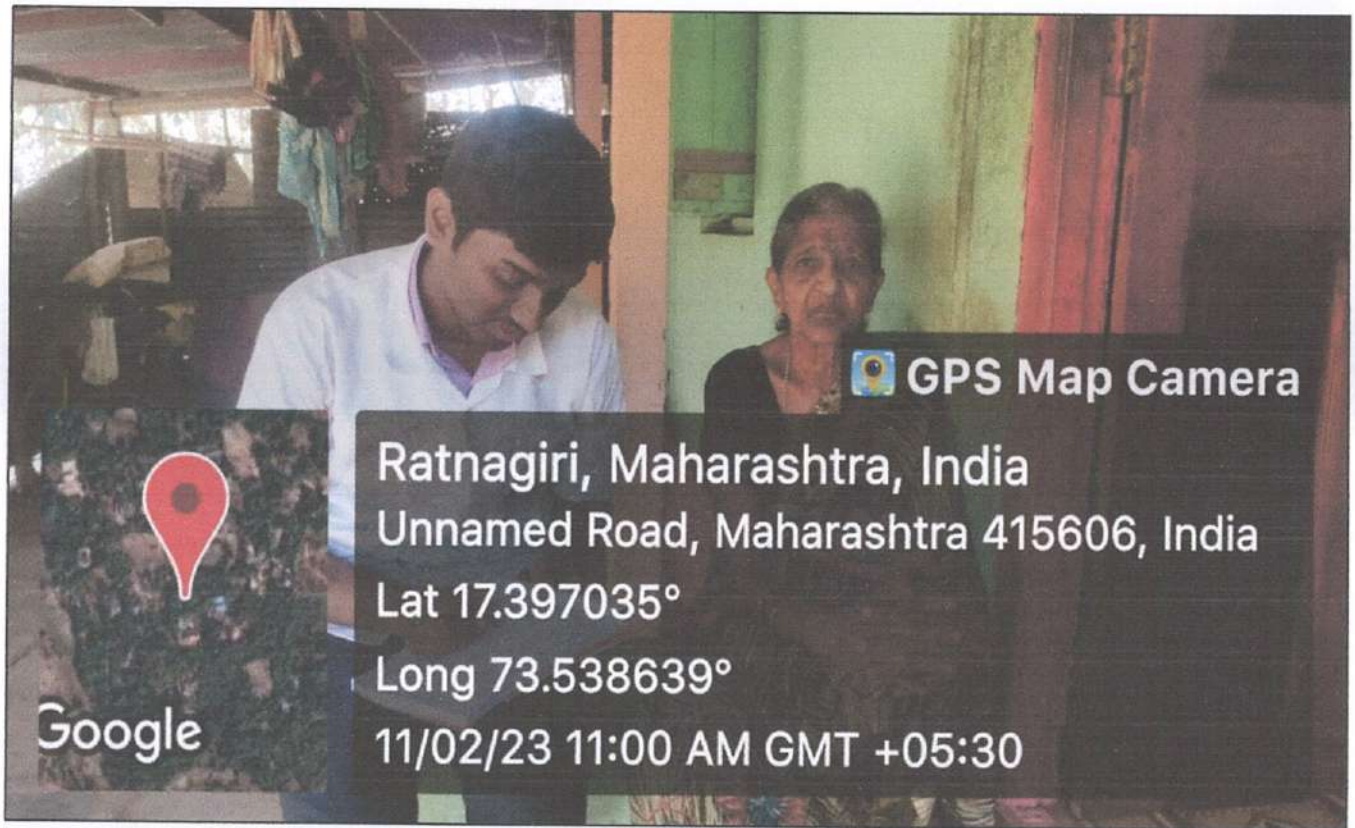
Previous Batch FAP Program

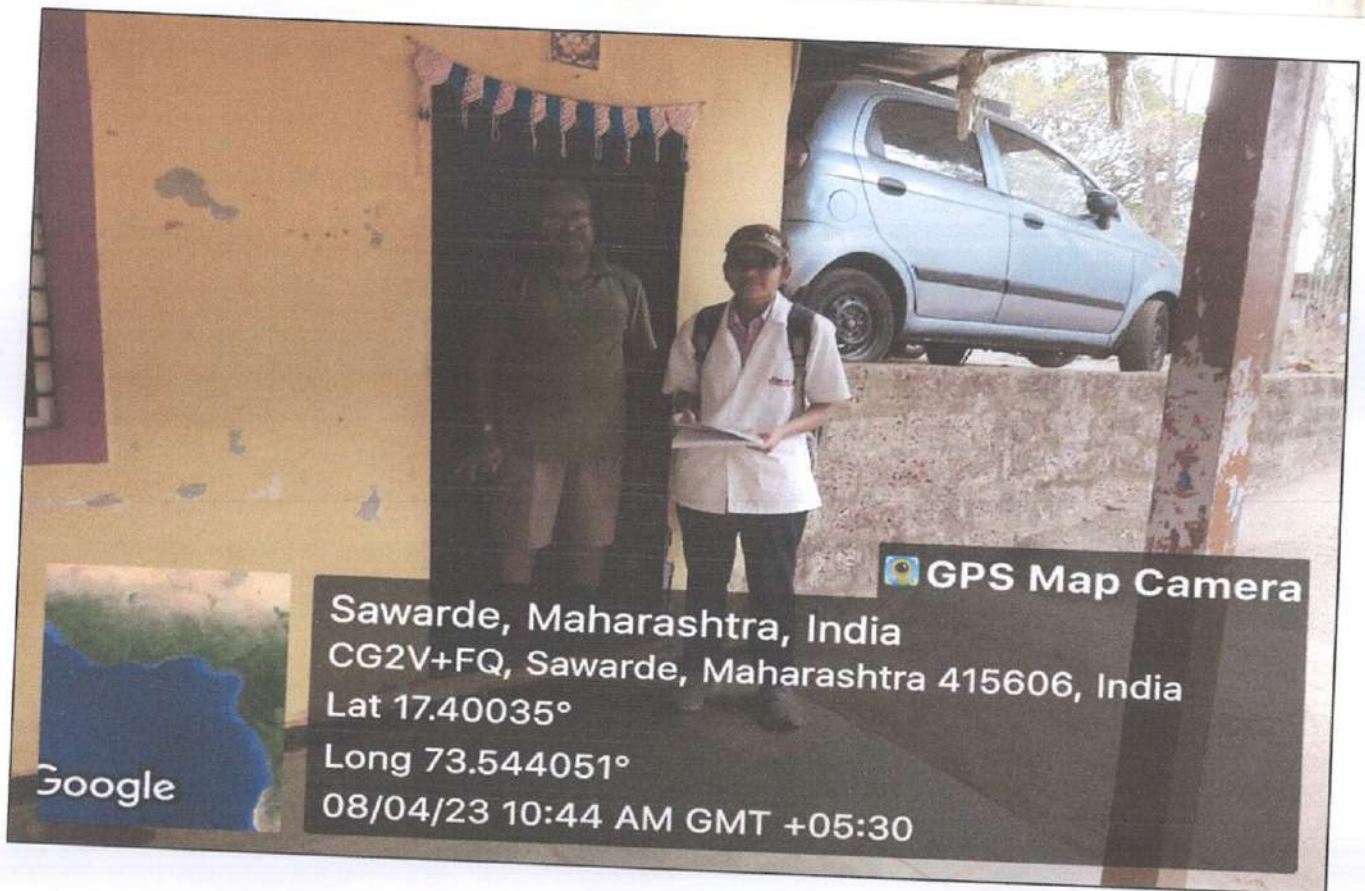
